When **ALGAE-KILL** is used as directed, it will kill and prevent development of *Chlorella pyrenoidosa* (green), *Thormidium inundatum* (black algae), *Phormidium retii* (Square D algae), *Lyngba versicolor* (blue-green) and other swimming pool algae. **NOTE:** Kill refers to initial dosage and prevent refers to maintenance dosage.

ALGAE-KILL is compatible with most commonly used swimming pool chemicals but should not be mixed with soap or other cleaners or premixed with other water treating chemicals. **ALGAE-KILL** works best when added by itself directly to pool water. **ALGAE-KILL** at use dilution is noncorrosive to inanimate surfaces.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Initial Dose: One gallon **ALGAE-KILL** to 50,000 gallons of water.

Maintenance Dose: One quart **ALGAE-KILL** to 50,000 gallons of water.

Initial dose is used when filling pool at beginning of swimming pool seasons. If pool has visible growth, treat with initial dose. Vacuum pool after 24 hours to remove algae debris. If visible algae are still present or reappear, repeat this treatment procedure as necessary. When pool is free from visible algae, use the recommended maintenance dose. Maintenance dose would be added at 3-5 day intervals. If high temperatures prevail or pool has unusually heavy use, add maintenance dose more frequently.

If makeup water is added at the rate of more than 10% per week of pool capacity, add one quart **ALGAE-KILL** for each 10,000 gallons of fresh make-up water per week.

When the swimming pool season is over, add one gallon of **ALGAE-KILL** to 50,000 gallons of water for treating water left in pool. This dose helps provide a measure of control of algae growth during the winter months. This treatment will also help the servicing of the pool before it is returned to use the following season.

This product is toxic to fish. Do not discharge treated effluent into lakes, streams or ponds.
